ANÁLISIS ARTÍSTICO

This sketch has the same composition as the final painting, although the main figures are depicted in less detail. The characters are rendered with just a few lines, while emphasis is placed on the figure pointing to the mountains in the background. The other figure is less detailed and their position is completely different to that depicted in the final version: they are shown twisted at a different angle in relation to the other figure, whose body is arched and head thrown back.
